Modesto's challenge

- Significant portion of community speaks Spanish, and many other languages
- 40% of Modesto's population is Hispanic (U.S. Census Bureau) many only speak Spanish
- Looking for service that allows residents to see / listen to city presentations in other languages at live meetings so everyone can participate
- Diverse community wanted a more consistent solution for the community that was technology based a lot of other cities using interpreters, and most are only offering on a "request" basis
 Wanted a solution for in-person and virtual meetings via Zoom

Modesto Solution

Al-powered translation and captions

- Selected Wordly AI-powered live translation and caption solution
- Spent three months testing and preparing the language access service for public use
- Enables members of community who don't speak English to listen, participate, and engage in city council meetings in person & Zoom
- Interprets speakers into over 60 languages
- Promotes transparency and engagement between city management and residents
- Accessed through a QR code or website gives participants the ability to choose their preferred language during the session
- First City in state of California to launch this service
- One of the few cities that offers a hybrid city council meeting option





 - Not just during business hours, which can be difficult for those with inflexible working hours


