



Bob Harrison is the City Manager in Yakima, Washington. Yakima is a full-service city with an annual budget of about \$230 million and 700 employees. His duties include the oversight of the city's Administrative, Airport, Community Development, Finance, Fire, Human Resources, Legal, Police, and Public Works departments.

Harrison was Renton's chief administrative officer from 2018 until May 2020.
